Dear Mr. Dillemath:

Eastern American Energy Corporation (EAEC) agrees to protect the waters of the Commonwealth, Whitely Creek, during withdrawals associated with the development of the Marcellus shale.

EAEC understands that Range Resources has also permitted the same withdraw point on Whitely Creek. EAEC will coordinate withdrawals with Range Resources to ensure that at least 20% pass-by of the Average Daily Flow is maintained at all times.

It is of utmost importance to EAEC that their work be conducted in compliance with all applicable regulations so as to minimize any adverse impacts to stream flow, water quality, or aquatic species. Please incorporate this agreement into Eastern American Energy Corporation's Greene County Water Management Plan.
